Analysis of the Role of Basic Education in Spreading Intangible Cultural Heritage of Music in Zaozhuang City

ABSTRACT

In 2021, the Ministry of Education clearly pointed out that it is necessary to reduce the burden of homework and off-campus training for students in compulsory education (referred to as "Double Reduction"). In addition, the comprehensive realization of quality-oriented education reform has entered an important stage in full swing, so it is urgent to optimize the teaching system of basic education in China. Music education, as an important part of basic education in China, takes the important responsibility of cultivating students' artistic emotion and intelligence development. The inheritance of intangible cultural heritage is of profound significance to the spread, innovation and development of Chinese excellent traditional culture. Therefore, this thesis discusses the role of basic education in spreading intangible cultural heritage of music, puts forward the measures for basic education to spread the intangible cultural heritage of music from the regional practical level. It probes into the communication strategy of music intangible cultural heritage in basic education in Zaozhuang City, a region with rich music intangible cultural resources, under the background of China's educational policy. This is of great value to promote the improvement of China's music teaching system and the development of music intangible cultural heritage. First of all, on the basis of discussing the role of basic education in spreading music intangible cultural heritage, this thesis takes Zaozhuang City, Shandong Province, China as the object. The "double reduction" policy, which aims to reduce the pressure on students by cleaning up the educational environment in and out of school, has been officially implemented. In the context of the "double reduction" policy, exploring high-quality and efficient measures for comprehensive quality education has become the current reform goal of China's basic education stage. Music education, which has not been highly emphasized in China's traditional basic education system, has become an essential direction of basic education reform in the "double reduction" policy. Compared with traditional subject education, music education plays a role in promoting students' artistic literacy. It plays a vital role in promoting the dissemination, inheritance and protection of music intangible cultural heritage and even integration and innovation in China, rich in music intangible cultural heritage. Therefore, it is necessary to explore specific measures for the dissemination of music intangible cultural heritage in basic education based on the clarification of the role of basic education in the dissemination of intangible cultural heritage, taking into account the regional cultural characteristics of China.

2. The Role of Basic Education in the Dissemination of Music-Based Intangible Cultural Heritage

a.It is conducive to promoting the transmission and protection of music intangible cultural heritage

It lays the educational foundation for the transmission and development of music intangible cultural heritage.

Moreover, the youth group at the basic education stage can also be inculcated with music intangible heritage culture, which injects fresh blood into the inheritance of music intangible cultural heritage. It can reduce the possibility of losing the excellent intangible heritage culture and solve the crisis of music intangible cultural heritage inheritance.

b.It is conducive to the high-quality dissemination of music-based intangible cultural heritage

Many of China's music intangible cultural heritages are derived from folk music, which draws on the essence of traditional Chinese culture in its transmission. However, the superficial interpretation of music intangible cultural heritage in transmission also causes its transmission to be more superficial, which lacks professionalism in the interpretation of its cultural characteristics, artistic elements and transmission values. The dissemination of music intangible cultural heritage from the basic education level and the promotion of music intangible cultural heritage through professional teachers and teaching atmosphere can deepen not only the interpretation of music intangible cultural heritage but also enhance students' awareness of cultural protection and inheritance based on modern aesthetic and cultural inculcation perspective. It promotes students' more profound understanding of music intangible heritage culture's ideological, cultural and artistic essence and promotes the high-quality dissemination of music intangible cultural heritage. At the same time, the educational and artistic values contained in many music intangible heritage cultures can also promote the ideological, cultural and spiritual civilization of students and contribute to the construction of harmonious campuses and the cultivation of outstanding talents.

c. It is conducive to promoting the integration and innovation of music-based intangible cultural heritage

As an integral part of China's excellent traditional culture, music intangible cultural heritage needs to keep pace with the times in the new era. However, the lack of innovation has become a shortcoming in the development of music intangible cultural heritage. The development of the dissemination channels of music intangible cultural heritage in basic education is of great value to promote its integration and innovation. On the one hand, the promotion of music intangible cultural heritage in basic education necessarily requires its selection and screening. The selection of intangible cultural heritage elements suitable for pedagogical application is based on the modern basic education level, thus promoting the integration of traditional music with the modern music education system. On the other hand, in China's modern music education system, the education of traditional music is limited to simple learning and imitation and focuses more on the innovation of traditional music. The promotion of appropriate teaching methods based on modern musical background and students' needs perspective has positively affected the innovative development of music intangible cultural heritage. In addition, the cultural intermingling between teachers and teachers, teachers and students, and students in China's basic education system will also bring favorable conditions for the cultural innovation of intangible heritage. The education system and even society as a whole will promote the sustainable development of Chinese traditional music.

3.Measures for The Dissemination of Music-Based Intangible Cultural Heritage in Basic Education In Zaozhuang City

Zaozhuang City, Shandong Province, a region rich in intangible heritage culture, focuses on the transmission and dissemination of intangible heritage culture in its policies and practices and the dissemination of music intangible cultural heritage in basic education. More and more teachers are involved in the intangible heritage cultural education program, contributing to the glow of music intangible heritage culture in Zaozhuang. It has made outstanding contributions to promote the improvement of the dissemination of music intangible heritage culture.

Summary

It also has important implications for the future innovative development of music intangible cultural heritage.
