



A Review Article - References of Raktamokshan in Sushrutsamhita

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ABSTRACT-

In today's fast-paced society; the population is more susceptible to lifestyle disorders. Increasing intake of fast foods which contain no nutritional value, stress caused by work causes late night sleep patterns, insomnia, irregular dietary habits, etc. all of these contribute to impure the blood. Raktamokshan is a great benefit in today's era to prevent such problems. Raktamokshan is a type of Panchakarma treatment modality that is classified under the Shodhan chikitsa. It is the process of blood letting by removing morbid Rakta dosha from body. The ancient Acharyas of Ayurveda has mentioned these treatment protocols many thousand of years ago. Acharya Sushruta described Raktamokshan in various diseases. In this article, references of Raktamokshan in Sushrut Samhita are mentioned.

Introduction –

Raktamokshan may be defined as the procedure by which the blood is allowed to let out from the body in a measured way.

Types of raktamokshan-

- A) Shastra visravana-
 - a. Pracchan
 - b. Siravyadh
- B) Anushashastra visravana-
 - a. Shringa
 - b. Alabu
 - c. Ghatiyantra
 - d. Jalauka
- A) Shastra visravana- Blood letting by using shastra i.e., instruments is called Shastra visravana. It is again of 2 types-
 - Pracchan – Small incision or pricking is made here over the skin by suitable instruments.
 - Siravyadh- Suitable vein is incised in this procedure by appropriate instruments.
- B) Anushashastra visravana- It is of 4 types as follows-
 - Shringa avacharana- After puncture, Shringa, a special type of instrument is used in this type.
 - Alabu avacharana- Alabu is used here for suction.
 - Ghatiyantra- Alabu and Ghati are more or less same in mechanism, where blood is let forcefully by creating artificial air suction.
 - Jalaukavacharana- In this procedure, Jalauka(Hirudino medicinalis) is used for suction of blood.
