National or statutory health insurance does not equate to government-run or government-financed health care, but is usually established by national legislation. In some countries, such as Australia's Medicare system, the UK's National Health Service and South Korea's National Health Insurance Service, contributions to the system are made via general taxation and therefore are not optional even though use of the health system it finances.






do you have health insurance ? 110 responses



are you aware about national health insurance scheme?




how much do you care about having health insurance policy ?  $_{\rm 110\,responses}$ 




Based on your experience of series of health insurance company will you refer health insurance of this company to other potential customers?



have you made any health insurance policy claim in last two years? 110 responses








#### 4. Findings

As 79.1% people are aware and have knowledge about national insurance health insurance among civil servants. People above 55 age care more about having national health policy. Based on their experience of series of Health Insurance Company they will not refer health insurance of this company to other potential customers as 40% of population said no and 39% said yes and rest maybe. Health insurance in India led to increased access to health care services as 39.1% strongly agree.

#### 5. Conclusion

Civil servants have comprehensive knowledge of the national health insurance scheme package as desirable tool for satisfying their health needs. Good knowledge of the objectives and mechanism of operation of the NHIS scheme characterized the civil servants under study.

The good knowledge of the components and fair attitude towards joining the scheme observed in this study could be improved upon, if stakeholders in the scheme could carry out adequate awareness seminars targeted at the civil servants.

This study suggests in India, awareness about health insurance is high.
