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Formulation and Evaluation of Polyherbal Facial Scrub

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ABSTRACT

The mainjective of present study was to prepare a polyherbal scrub incorporated into gel. The use of natural ingredients to fight against acne, wrinkle and also to control secretion of oil is known as natural or herbal cosmetics. Herbal cosmecuticals usually contain the plant parts which possess antimicrobial, antioxidant and anti-aging properties. Herbal cosmetics are the safest product to use routine with no side effects and cosmecuticals are the product which influences the biological function of skin. In this preparation fenugreek, coffee, coconut oil, rose water, turmeric, Aloe Vera gel, amla, honey ,sodium lauryl sulfate, methyl parabens, glycerine is used as active ingredients and incorporated into the gel which is prepared with carbopol of different The main objective of present study was to prepare a polyherbal scrub incorporated into gel. The use of natural ingredients to fight against acne, wrinkle and also to control secretion of oil is known as natural or herbal cosmetics.

INTRODUCTION:

Facial scrub is a cosmetic or a beauty product or a treatment which cleanses and exfoliates the skin of the face or body. Facial scrubs are beneficial to remove dirt, skin cells and sebum or oil, blackheads and Whiteheads. It helps to maintain skin appearance.[1]

There are three kinds of skin types, oily skin, sensitive skin and dry skin. For a person with dry skin must use the facial scrub, which contains the moisturizing and hydrating ingredients. If the person is having sensitive skin, he or she should use gentle scrub. And the person with oily skin should be using an exfoliation which prevents pimples dullness and breakouts and helps to control oiliness.[2]

Depending on the skin types facial scrubs are advised to use twice or thrice a week. But for the newbies, facial scrubs are recommended to use weekly. People with dry or sensitive skin types should only exfoliate one or two times a week. In some conditions, peoples with acne prone skin are recommended to use products containing salicylic acid and dermatologist-grade 4% glycolic and polyhydroxy acid complex. This helps to exfoliate skin and clear acne with giving smoother appearance.[3]

BENEFITS OF SCRUBBING SKIN

- Helps in Removing Dead Cells: Facial or body scrubs are the cosmetic which goes beyond surface level to remove dead skin and reveal the healthy glowing skin below.
- 2. Free the skin form Flakes: Loss of upper layer of skin (epidermis) is called as flaky skin. It gives rise to dry patches. Scrubbing your skin can help you to deal with flaky skin effectively.
- 3. Deep Cleaning of Skin: Scrubbing your skin helps skin to get free from dirt, oil and sweat. Other cleansing like face wash facial cleansers cannot clean the skin.
- 4. Thoroughly removingdustaccumulated in the course of the skin, scrubbing does this work effectively.
- Clears Blemishes: Accumulation of dead skin, can block the pores of skin and causes blemishes. Scrubbing frequently helps to remove dead skin and clears blemishes
- 6. Gives glow to skin and smooth texture: Scrubbing actually helps to give glow and smooth texture to skin.
- 7. Remove the Acne Scars: As scrubbing used to remove dead skin cells, it also remove the acnes scars from skin.
- 8. Promotes Hydration of Skin: Facial scrubs contents moisturizing agents and hydrating Agents. Exfoliation of skin helps to absorb moisture and it leaves our skin with filling soft and .
- 9. Reduces Stress: Exfoliation or scrubbing the skin gives good massage, which gives relaxing feeling and reduces stress.[4]

Facial scrubs are solid or semisolid systems of at least two constituents, containing various natural and chemical ingredients which are safer to use and having fewer side effects and they also possesses antiseptic, anti-infective, antioxidant, anti-aging and humectant properties.

The scrubs are made by simple mixing methods of two or more ingredients herbal or chemical such as honey, aloe vera, turmeric powder, Glycerine, Coffee powder, lauryl sulphate, anhydrous citric acid, etc.

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OBJECTIVE

The main objective of present study was to prepare a herbal facial scrub. In this formulation of herbal facial scrub, we used fenugreek as a active ingredientand honey, amla powder, coffee, rose water, aloevera, turmeric etc are other ingredients used in this facial scrub formulation. Different evaluations tests are carried out for the prepared herbal facial scrub formulation, such as appearance, spreadability, irritability, PH, washability, etc. Prepared formulation passes all the given evaluation tests. Thus, the prepared formulation of herbal facial scrub was effective for healthy, clear and glowing skin.

Skin care with herbal exfoliants :

The given article gives the different types of exfoliation methods such as manual or mechanical skin exfoliation, chemical exfoliation, enzyme exfoliation. The formulation is from luffa, algae extract, grapefruit seed extract, apricot shell, cucumber extract, papaya extract, mung dal, pineapple extract, rosehip seed powder, cranberry, green tea, tree tomato. Herbal skin exfoliation is important part of general skin maintenance. It smoothens and chemically balances skin, unclogs pores and stimulates fresh cell growth, reducing blemishes, discoloration and wrinkles which helps the skin stays healthy and clean, hydrated and blemish free. The Formulation is based on herbal scrub using limonia acidissima. The objective behind the study was to prepare multi purposeherbal scrub in the form of gel that are used for their medicinal and cosmetic properties and limonia acidissima is one of them. The valuable part of plant includes its roots, fruits bark and leaves which are used for various therapeutic purposes. Extraction of fruit parts were done and incorporated to gel phase. The formulation contains ethanol extract of Limonia acidissima fruit pulp which possess antioxidant, anti-aging, anti-wrinkle, skin tightening, lightening and brightening property. They can exfoliate skin without scratching skin surface by applying pressure on them. Suitable base materials such as gelling agents, preservative, neutralizer and foaming agents were selected and incorporated into extract to design a suitableherbal gel. The formulation was evaluated using various parameters and found to be satisfied upon application to skin.[6]

Deep cleansing apricot scrub is a proprietary& patented polyherbal formulation designed to deep cleanse the skin and makes it healthy and glowing.

Exfoliation involves the removal of the oldest superficial dead skin cells on the skin's outermost surface. Exfoliation can be achieved through mechanical or chemical means mechanical process involves physically scrubbing the skin with abrasive .[7]

This type of facial treatment is type of treatment generally chosen by some women's. Facial is a procedure to clear facial skin from all types of facial treatment impurities. Such as pimples, Whiteheads, blackheads and others.[9,10]

There are two types of facial soap

- Face wash.
- Face Scrub.

Facial wash is used to clean the face from dirt and dust. Facial scrubs are used to help exfoliate dead skin cells. Scrub functions to remove dead skin cells on the surface of body's skin which is rough and dull.[11,12]

- iv. Exfoliates Skin: It not only removes the dead skin cells but also reduces excess oil from the skin.
- v. Moisturizes Skin: Fenugreek seeds nourish and moisturize the skin by removing all the dryness.[14]

Highly popular and used in cosmetic treatment honey used in preparing hair conditioner and face wash, etc. Honey is the only insect derived natural product which has therapeutic and cosmetic as well as nutritional values Honey has been used for both as food and in medicines since ancient times[31]. Honey is one of the most appreciated and valued natural products approximately 300 varieties of honey have been identified although there

are many nutritional studies of honey.[32,33]

Sodium lauryl sulphate (SLS):

In cosmetics, sodium lauryl sulphate is most often used as an emulsifier or surfactant. As an emulsifier, sodium lauryl sulphate helps to stabilize and thicken solutions with ingredients of differing solubility. This allows products to achieve a more uniform texture for easier, and smoother application.[34]

• METHYL PARABEN:

Methyl paraben is one of the most common parabens. You can find it as part of a paraben mix in most cosmetic products, where it prevents germ growth. It can also be found naturally in some fruits and may be used as a food preservative or an antifungal preservative.[35]

• GLYCERIN:

Glycerine is reported to function in cosmetics as a denaturant, fragrance ingredient, hair conditioning agent, humectant, oral care agent, oral health-care drug, skin protectant, skin conditioning agent—humectant, and viscosity-decreasing agent.[36]

EVALUATION:

Evaluation parameter for facial scrub:

♦ Appearance :

> Colour:

Yellowish brown colour of facial scrub was observed by visual examination

> Odour:

Odour found to be characteristics. Sweet and simple syrup like odour.

> State:

Semisolid state of scrub observed by visually.

> Consistency:

Consistency was found to be smooth with visual observation.

> PH

PH of the prepared gel evaluated by using PH paper . Small amount of scrub applied on PH paper.

PH was found in the range of 4-6.

> Spreadability:

It is used to identify spreadability of the gel on the skin.

 $Small\ quantity\ of\ sample\ placed\ on\ a\ glass\ slide\ then\ another\ slide\ placed\ above\ them.$

Amount of weight placed on slide, then it spread on slide and how much time it taken for spread is measured.

It calculated by using formula:

 $S = m \times L/t$

S= spreadability

M= weight placed on slide (1gm)

L= length of glass slide (7.5cm)

T= time taken in seconds (22 sec)

Spreadability was found to be 0.34gm.cm/sec

> Irritability:

Small amount of gel applied on skin and kept for few minutes and found to be non-irritable.

> Washability:

Small quantity of gel applied on the skin and wash with water after few minutes found to be washable with water.

➢ Grittiness:

Exfoliants need to abrasive property so fenugreek seeds powdered and pass through sieve then this preparation has few gritty particles observed.

Foaming Index

Add 1 gm formulation in 5ml water in test tube, shake it for 5 min. Allow it to stand for 15min. Observe the foam in cm. If the height of foam is less than 1 cm, the foaming index is less than 100. If the height of foam is more than 1 cm then it is over 1000.

Foaming index =1000/a

Where, a = in ml in the test tube showing 1cm height.
