Economy is considered harsh when a nation's economy experiences a persistent rise in the general prices of goods and services (inflation), negative gross domestic product (GDP), rising levels of unemployment, deteriorating health state of citizens, falling retail sales, and falling standard of living for an extended period of time. It is an expression used to describe a pessimistic or negative economic outlook.

Accordingly, Nigeria's annual growth rate continued to reach 27.3% in October 2023, the highest since August 2005 and up from 26.7% in the previous month. Inflationary pressures have intensified in recent months due to the weakness of the naira after the government removed fuel subsidies in May and the central bank's decision to reduce foreign exchange transactions in June. Food prices, the largest item in the CPI basket, rose 31.5% in October from 30.6% the previous month, the highest since August 2005, due to concerns over security in food production areas. Other CPI categories, including housing and electronics, clothing, footwear and transportation, also increased. The annual inflation rate, excluding agricultural products, rose to 22.7% in October, compared to 22.1% in September. On a quarterly basis, consumer spending increased by 1.7% in October, following a 2.1% increase in the previous month (National Bureau of Statistics, 2023).

The above repot shows that Nigeria is in a very serious state of economic backwardness as things keep going higher each and everyday. This has an adverse effect on the general wellness of the economy. The current state of the economy has become a pain in the neck as survival becomes difficult. This has led to vices like bribery, corruption, kidnapping, banditry, cultism, vandalism, burglary, theft, etc.

Impact of Quality Education

The following are ways quality education can help ameliorate the effect of economic harshness on our nation, Nigeria.

i. Creating Equal Opportunities

UNESCO strives to ensure that everyone receives a quality education, regardless of their socio-economic status, gender, race or place of residence. Educational equality means that two children with the same abilities should receive equal support to develop those abilities, regardless of their parents' circumstances. Educational equality occurs when a child's education does not depend on the financial status or state of residence of their parents. Agbarevo (1996) in Chibuike (2022) argued that equity in education can also be seen as the provision of education necessary to enable every Nigerian citizen to lead a productive life in the society without disposing of his or her capabilities and its potential, discrimination based on race, religion, gender and economic origin. This means that all Nigerian citizens should be able to adapt to an education system that is inclusive of people with disabilities.
