Proactive Mechanism: The US has killed the leader of al-Qaeda, Ayman al-Zawahiri, in a drone strike in Afghanistan

Defensive Mechanism: The Demining Research Community, for example, has developed a drone that uses images and machine learning to locate mines with 92 percent accuracy. Mine Kafon, another organization, uses a team of two drones to locate land mines—the first creates a 3-D visualization of the target area and the second collects data using a metal detector, radar and a sample collection device. This data is then used to train mine-detecting software, which locates the mines on the 3-D map. On autopilot mode, this system can detect land mines with an accuracy of four centimetres, though it can also be flown manually, per the organization's website.
