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# A Review Article: Medicinal, Astrological and Religious Comprehensive Description of Rudraksha

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#### ABSTRACT

Rudrksha is very popular plant in ayurveda which give medicinally and astrologically very powerful benefits in human life because it's believed that it originated from tears of lord shiva.

Along with scientific form, Rudraksha plays an important role in the daily life of man spiritually and it possesses such special properties that it can cure many incurable diseases. Through bio-chemical analysis, electromagnetic analysis and chemical constitution of Rudraksha, all the chemical information about Rudraksha can be obtained. Correct information about its scientific properties shows that it is a very effective plant which will be very useful for our medical science as well as it also has traditional mythological and astrological value which tell about different types of Rudraksha, generally it have 1-14 face (Mukhi) and there are different value contain each type of rudraksha. Rudraksha is also full of many medicinal and pharmacological activity like analgesic, antioxidant, antifungal, anti depressant etc. which have being used by modern medical science.

# 1. INTRODUCTION

Rudraksha bead or scientifically Elaeocarpus ganitrus (L.) fruit owes a great spiritual and medicinal importance in traditional system of medicine. Several review studies quoted the medicinal benefits of wearing Rudraksha beads against neurological and cardiovascular disorders, rheumatism, infertility and other diseases based upon Ayurvedic system of medicine.

In addition, it has also been stated that the pharmacological properties of Rudraksha bead differs from each other based upon the type of grooves or Mukhis, which enclosed a dense cellular endosperm comprising of calcium oxalate druses fruits are popular from ancient times for their mythological, aesthetic and medicinal.

Elaeocarpus ganitrus trees grow up to 20 meter and are found from the Gangetic plain in the foothills of the Himalayas to China, South and Southeast Asia, parts of Australia, and Guam and Hawaii.Rudraksha trees are commonly found in mountain and hilly areas of Nepal, Indonesia Javaand Sumatra. Dried Rudrakasha bead is obtained from the ripe fruit of Elaeocarpus ganitrusroxb. Microscopic studies revealed the presence of a hard endocarp with lignified isodiametric sclereids, seeds with membranous seed coat).

The word Rudraksha, literally imitative from two Sanskrit words – 'rudra', a synonym for Lord Shiva and 'aksha' meaning eyes. It is also called blueberry beads because beads are sheltered by an outer shell of The blue color on fully ripening. The folklore states about the plant that the three demons, Tripurasuras were having inestimable powers. They lived in Purams which was built in the sky and revolved in the region of the space. The Purams were cosseted by a fortunate thing from Lord Ganesha that nonentity can harm them, unless they come into a single axis.

That moment comes only once in every thousand years. Prayed by all gods, Lord Shiva resolute to kill those demons. Lord Shiva did tapasya (meditation) with half-closed eye (Ardhanimeelitaneetra). He opened his eyes, strenuous on the axis and burnt Tripurams. Due to the stress caused by tapasya, tears

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came out his eyes while opening them and they turned into rudraksha. The fruits of this plant are commonly known as Rudraksha and have been used in Ayurvedic traditional medicine for the treatment of mental diseases, epilepsy, asthma, hypertension, arthritis and liver diseases.

E. ganitrus fruits be full of glycosides, steroids, alkaloids and flavonoids. Apart from this, it has been found that the exocarp of the fruit provisions a nutritious incentive to consumers, predominantly rich in carbohydrates (21.0% dry mass, or 0.58 g per fruit) and proteins (4.3% dry mass, or 0.12g per fruit).

## 1.2. BIOCHEMICAL ANALYSIS

In the Rudraksha may biochemical constituents are presence like glycosides, alkaloids, minerals, vitamins, steroids, flavanoid, gallic acid, ellagic acid andquercetin in Rudraksha. The ethanolic fruit extract of Rudraksha and reported the presence of alkaloids, glycosides, phenolic compounds, flavonoids, saponins, carbohydrates and fixed oils, but protein and amino acids were absent in this extract. screened the presence of phytochemical in hexane, chloroform, ethyl acetate, acetone and methanol extracts of Rudraksha.

## 1.3. ELECTROMAGNETICAL ANALYSIS

Electromagnetic properties in Rudrakshahave been reported by several reviewers, where Rudraksha was mentioned as a famous electromagnetic bead helpful in curing several chronic disorders. Stated the healing mechanism of Rudraksha due to its electromagnetic property. The study reported that the electromagnetic properties of Rudrakshabeads activate body's energy wheel, which in turn influences the bioelectrical properties of human body and heals various chronic diseases like blood pressure, heart rate, diabetes, gynaecological problem, neurological disorders, mental problem, insomnia and rheumatism. In another report Tripathy mentioned that rotation of Rudraksha between two copper coins is an evidence of its electromagnetic property.

## 1.4. CHEMICAL CONSTITUENTS

Phytoconstituent such as glycosides, steroids, alkaloids and flavonoids are found in E.ganitrus fruit. Apart from this, fruit extract also provide nutritious rewards to consumers, especially those that are rich in carbohydrates (21.0% dry weight, or 0.58 g per fruit) and protein (4.3% dry weight, or 0.12g per fruit). Quercetin, gallic and ellagic acid are present in the leaves of E.ganitrus. Singh says that a significant amount of phytocomponents such as isoelaeocarpicine, elaeocapine etc.

 diOacetyl)-a-rhamnoside are used in multi besieged therapy of cancer and a significant antioxidant ability due to its wealthy content of tannins and flavonoids.

### 1.5. TRADITIONAL USES OF RUDRAKSHA

Unriped and riped fruits of Elaeocarpus sphaericus shows different traditional uses:

- Elaeocarpus sphaericus imposes positive effect on stress, anxiety, depression, palpitation and lack of concentration.
- It cools down the body temperature and brings calm to mind. Those who suffer from anxiety should keep big size five mukhi Elaeocarpus
  sphaericus with themselves and whenever they feel nervous; they should hold them tight in their right palm for ten minutes. It will help them
  to regain their confidence and their body becomes stable.
- Elaeocarpus sphaericus also possess anti ageing property.
- Elaeocarpus sphaericus is also useful in mental diseases. Milk boiled with four faced rudraksha seed is good medicine for mental diseases.
   This also helps in increasing memory.
- Elaeocarpus sphaericus is also good for women's who suffering from hysteria and coma.
- Elaeocarpus sphaericus is also good for children's who suffers from frequent fever.
- Elaeocarpus sphaericus also helps to cure prolonged cough, the paste of ten- faced rudraksha with milk relieves prolonged cough. This
  medicine should take thrice a day. It can be used as a cure for skin diseases, sores, ringworms, pimples, boils and burns also.
- To cure small pox equal quantity of black pepper and Elaeocarpus sphaericus should powdered and taken with water.

Modern science has shown that the electromagnetic nature of rudraksha beads affect our neurophysiology in a specific manner that allows control of heart beat, blood pressure, stress levels, hypertension and at the same time relieves anxiety, depression and neurotic condition.

Rudraksha can be used even for the treatment of chronic diseases like cancer either used externally by wearing it or an oral administered by drinking milk of rudraksha beads boiled in it and taking the finest dust of rudraksha mixed with water and different mukhi dust are used for different diseases.

## 4. PHARMACOLOGICAL ACTIVITIES OF ELAEOCARPUS GANITRUS

Brain related and many other types of disease.

#### Antiasthmatic activity

Chloroform, acetone, petroleum ether, benzene and ethanolic extracts of Elaeocarpus sphaericus fruits were found to have mast-cell stabilizing activity, substantiating the effectiveness of Elaeocarpus sphaericus in bronchial asthama. In other study the petroleum ether, benzene, chloroform, acetone and ethanol extracts protected guinea pigs against bronchospasm induced by acetylcholine aerosols and histamine.

## • Anti hypertensive

Hypertension is the leading cause of cardiovascular disease worldwide. Despite a diversity of pharmacological agents to treat high blood pressure, suboptimal control remains a significant problem in as many as 43% of patients and this rate has not significantly improved over the past two decades. Fruits of rudraksha shown anti hypertensive activity on many cases.

#### • Antimicrobial activity

Elaeocarpus ganitrus is an evergreen tree found worldwide. Antimicrobial activity of the aqueous extract of leaves of E. ganitrus was tested against clinical isolates of bacteria and fungi. In vitro antimicrobial activity was performed by agar well diffusion method on Mueller Hinton agar and Sabouraud Dextrose agar for bacterial and fungal cultures.

#### • Antianxiety effect

Anxiety is a mental disorder it is characterized by excessive, uncontrollable and often irrational worry about everyday things that is disproportionate to the actual source of worry, it is diagnosed as generalized anxiety disorder (GAD). The petroleum ether (PE), chloroform (CE), ethanol (EE) and water extractives (WE) of Centaurea behen and Elaeocarpus ganitrus were prepared and evaluated for antianxiety activity in mice using elevated plus maize model

The results were compared with standard drug, diazepam. The ethanol extractive of C. behen (200 mg/kg) and chloroform and ethanol extractives of E. ganitrus (200 and 400 mg/kg) significantly increased the time spent and percentage of the open arm entries in the elevated plus maize model and hence exhibited antianxiety activity, which was comparable to diazepam. Chemically the extracts of both the plants showed the presence of phytosterols, fats, alkaloids, flavonoids, carbohydrates, proteins and tannins

## Antidiabetic

The anti diabetic effect of Elaeocarpus ganitrus was evaluated in rats by single dose at three graded dose levels, 250,500,1000mg/kg body weight. Anti hyperglycemic activity of the extract was also evaluated at the same dose level in streptozotocin (60 mg/kg, ip) induced diabetic rats during a 30-days treatment period.

Metformin (500mg/ kg) was used as the reference drug. Fasting blood glucose and lipid parameters, viz. triglycerides, total cholesterol, highdensity lipoprotein and low density lipoprotein levels were measured. Acute oral toxicity of the extract was carried out in Swiss albino mice.

The investigation shows that Elaeocarpus ganitrus seeds have potential anti diabetic effects. In another study water extract of leaves, fruits and twigs of Elaeocarpus grandiflorus shows alloxan induced anti diabetic activity.

## • Antifungal

Elaeocarpus ganitrus have antifungal activity the chloroform and ethanol extracts of Elaeocarpus ganitrus have high antifungal activity against Candida albicans. Whereas, chloroform, ethanol and water extract showed moderate inhibition against Aspergillus niger.

# Antidepressant

Antidepressant effect The water portion of 90% ethanol extract of the fruits of Elaeocarpus ganitrus showed the presence of a prominent central nervous system depressant effect, characterized by typical behavioral actions, potentiating of hexobarbitone hypnosis and morphine analgesia anticonvulsant and anti-amphetamine effects.

In addition the extract showed a cardio stimulant, depressor, smooth muscle relaxant and hydrocholeretic activities, part of these being mediated through beta adrenoreceptor stimulation and in part through a direct musculotropic effect. The pharmacological profile of activity of the extract substantiates the use of the plant fruits in the treatment of mental diseases, epilepsy, hypertension, asthma and liver diseases in the ancient Indian systems of medicines.

# Anti-asthmatic

The E. sphaericus fruits showed effect on autocoid release during study conducted on rat mesenteric mast cell. The petroleum ether, benzene, chloroform, acetone and ethanol extracts of E. sphaericus fruits were found to have mast-cell stabilizing activity, substantiating the efficacy of E. sphaericus against bronchial asthma.

#### 5. Conclusion

In current survey review of literature on rudraksha give more knowledge about traditional and spiritual value in our life pharmacological properties of Rudraksha bead differs from each other based upon the type of grooves or Mukhis, which enclosed a dense cellular endosperm comprising of calcium oxalate druses fruits are popular from ancient times for their mythological, aesthetic and medicinal.

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
