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A Literature Review of Arogyavardhini Vati

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ABSTRACT:

The oldest systematic body of knowledge that expresses reality through philosophical sketching is *Ayurveda*. *Ayurveda* means "The Science of Life" in Sanskrit. Many of the traditional remedies used by *Ayurvedic* doctors to treat a variety of diseases are effective, but most of the time there is insufficient information available about how exactly they work. One such multi-drug traditional formulation that is commonly used in *Ayurveda* medicine is called *Arogyavardhini vati*. The purpose of this article is to compile all available data and scholarly works pertaining to one of the traditional interpretations of "*Arogyavardhini Vati*". Enhancing the digestive system helps flush out impurities, balance body fats, increase digestive fire (*agni dipana*), and open up channels for nutrients to enter the tissues. This is applied to all three *Dosha* imbalances. According to the traditional *Ayurvedic* experts, each successful doctor has a wide range of relevant medication expertise.

For the treatment of a variety of medical ailments, *Ayurveda* advises using both plant- and mineral-based medications. In order to achieve the desired result, these traditional medications should be carefully examined before being administered to the patient. Many multidrug formulations are successfully used in *Ayurvedic* clinics, but the majority of them suffer from a lack of information on their precise mechanism of action. One such formulation that is frequently used is *Arogyavardhini vati*, which is one of the *Kharaleeya Rasayan*.

The definition of *Arogyavardhini* is destroy all the diseases and promotes health. *Arogyavardhini vati* as *Sarvaroga prashamani* (can specify all type of illnesses) was mentioned by *Rasaratna Samucchaya*. For decades, people have used this traditional *Ayurvedic* mixture, which is said to be safe and effective in treating a variety of ailments.

Fine powder of above ingredient is triturate with the juice of *Nimba* leaves for two days. Then it made into paste and pills are prepared as equal size of *Raja-kola* (variety of Indian jujube fruit). As per *Acharya Hariprasanna Sharma* prepared size will be like *Kshudrakola*. It is black colour and bitter in taste. Normal dose has mentioned by the scholar is 500mg- 1gm per day.

INDICATION

The medicine Arogyavardhini, according to Rasaratnasamucchaya, Bhaisajyaratnavali, and Bharatbhaisajyaratnakar, Vati have the following pharmacological actions:

1. *Kusthanasaka* (which treats all kinds of skin disorders): It works particularly well when applied to *Kushtas* that are *Vata-Kapha* predominant or *Vata* and *Kapha* predominate, such as *Kapala, Mandal Vipadika, Charmdaladi, and Alasaka*. A similar amount of milk should be drunk for the course of this medication.

2. Tridosha Jvara Nashaka, a five-day treatment for fever resulting from the participation of three humors.

3. Helpful for constipation: *Triphala Kwath* along with *Arogyavardhini Vati* works wonders for this condition. It melts, emerges, and softens the intestines before beginning to function properly.

4. In addition, the medication has qualities such as Pathya (wholesome), Pachani (digestive), and Dipani (appetiser)

5.Arogyavardhini in Yakrut vikara

The *Moolashtana of Raktavaha Srotas* are *Yakrut and Pleeha*. Modern science now knows that the liver, or *yakrut*, has two primary purposes, generating *Yakrut Pitta* (Bile), which is required for meal digestion. *Rakta Dhatu* is associated with another function. *Ayurveda* states that the *Moolasthana* is the cause of the *Dushti* of the *Raktavaha Srotas*, and that any deviation from this affects the entire *Srota*.

Anupana (Adjuvant) : The medicine Arogyavardhani Vati can be prescribed with various types of adjuvant as per condition of disease pathology and the patients.

1. Moong Dal- Vigna radiate, Masur Dal- Lens culinaris, Arhar- Cajanus cajan, Urad Dal - Vigna mungo (L.)

2. Ghrita: Ghee (ghee made from cow milk); Dadhi: Curd (curd from cow milk); Godugdha: Milk (cow milk); Loni: Butter Milk.

- 3. Parwal Trichosanthes dioica
- 4. Sugarcane juice and Jaggery
- 5. Dashamula Kwatha and Punarnavadi Kwatha.

It supports the preservation of a healthy skeletal, respiratory, circulatory, reproductive, and excretory systems in addition to the digestive system. It flushes out impurities, balances lipids in the body, and stimulates the digestive fire .

CONCLUSION

Arogyavardhini vati improves overall good health by balancing all the *three Dosha*. The drug does not have appreciable toxicological effects on brain, liver and kidney. This is also known as natural liver detoxifying and fatty liver remedy.

DISCUSSION

Arogyavardhini Vati is one of the most effective and widely used Ayurvedic preparations which help to manage various disease conditions

1. As it is Kapha-Pitta Shamaka, Shothakara, and Rakta Shudhhikar properties (Blood Purifier) it is very useful in various skin diseases like Kushta, Mukhdushika.

2. Vatanulomak and Rechana action of Arogyavardhini help to manage Malavshtambha (Constipation)

3. Arogyavardhini Vati is an effective Ayurvedic preparation that use in Medoroga it helps to reduce weight by reducing Ama due to its Dipan and Pachana properties. It also helps to eliminate the waste product from the body because of its Shodhan nature

4. Arogyavardhini Vati is one of the most effective Ayurvedic preparations which is used in the management of various diseases of Annavaha Strotas like anorexia due to its Tridoshahar (balancing Vata, Pitta, and Kapha) properties. It improves digestion due to its Dipana and Pachana properties

5. Arogyavardhini Vati properties like Dipana, Pachana, Pathya, Tridoshashamak and Strotoshodhak activity help in minimizing the symptoms of Anemia.

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
