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A Review on Herbal Shampoo

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ABSTRACT

The main object of this present study is to prepare and evaluate an herbal Shampoo and determine physiochemical function that emphasizes on safety, Efficacy and quality of the product Herbal Shampoo is the natural haircare product Which is use to remove grease, dirt, dandruff and promote hair growth, Strenthness and darkness of the hair. Synthetic shampoo shows harmful effect on hair and scalp like dryness of hair and keratinloss .due to these reasons herbal shampoo has evolved as an alternative to synthetic shampoo because of safe and traditionally use ingredients .This Polyherbal shampoo was formulated by using natural ingredients like Aloe vera (Barbatensis miller), Neem leaves (Azadirachta indica), Reetha fruit (Emblica officinallis), Hibiscus leaves (Hibiscus rosa cinensis) with proven efficacy. The main objective of this study was to eliminate harmful synthetic ingredient from herbal shampoo formulation and substitute them with a safe natural ingredient

FUNCTION OF HEARBAL SHAMPOO:

- 1. Lubrication
- Conditioning
- 3. Hair Growth
- 4. Maintenance of Hair growth
- 5. Medications

EVALUATION PARAMETERS:

- 1) Visual assessment-The prepared formulation was assessed for color, clarity, odor, and froth content. 2.3.2
- 2) pH determination-The pH of the prepared herbal shampoo in distilled water (10% v/v) was evaluated by means of pH analyzer at room temperature
- 3) Percentage of solid content determination: 4g of shampoo is taken in a previously weighed evaporating dish and evaporated by placing the evaporating dish on the hot plate. The final weight is noted down. Percentage of solid contents of shampoo left after complete evaporation is calculated.
- 4) Foaming ability and Foaming stability: The cylinder shake method is employed in the foaming ability and stability test. In this method 50ml of the 1% shampoo solution is taken in a 250ml graduated cylinder and covered the cylinder with hand. The cylinder is then shaken for 10 times. The volume of the foam appeared due to shaking is measured after every one minute consecutively for 5 minutes.
- 5) Dirt dispersion test: About 1% of shampoo solution taken in a test tube and 1 drop of India ink is added. The test tube is stoppered and shaken for about 10 mins. The amount of ink present in the foam is indicated as None, light, moderate, or heavy.
- 6) Cleansing action: The cleansing property of the herbal shampoo was evaluated by the application of the shampoo on hair that has not been washed for seven days. The shampoo was used to wash the hair of human subject that had applied oil 4-5 hours before washing. The performance of the shampoo was assessed on its ability to remove oily dirt from scalp.
- 7) Froth stability test: The stability of the froth was determined using cylinder shake system. About 50 ml of formulated soap(1) result was taken in a graduated cylinder of 250 ml capacity and shaken for 10 times roundly. Froth stability was measured by recording the froth volume of shake test after 1 min and 4 min, independently. The total froth volume was measured after 1 min of shaking.
- 8) . Skin irritation test: Apply the solution of prepared shampoo on skin and kept for 5 minutes and observed for redness of skin and irritation there, were no any red colouration and the irritation to the skin.
- 9) Viscosity: Viscosity was determined by using the Ostwald viscometer.
