6. Administration and Reporting: Offers admin dashboard, content management, and reporting analytics.

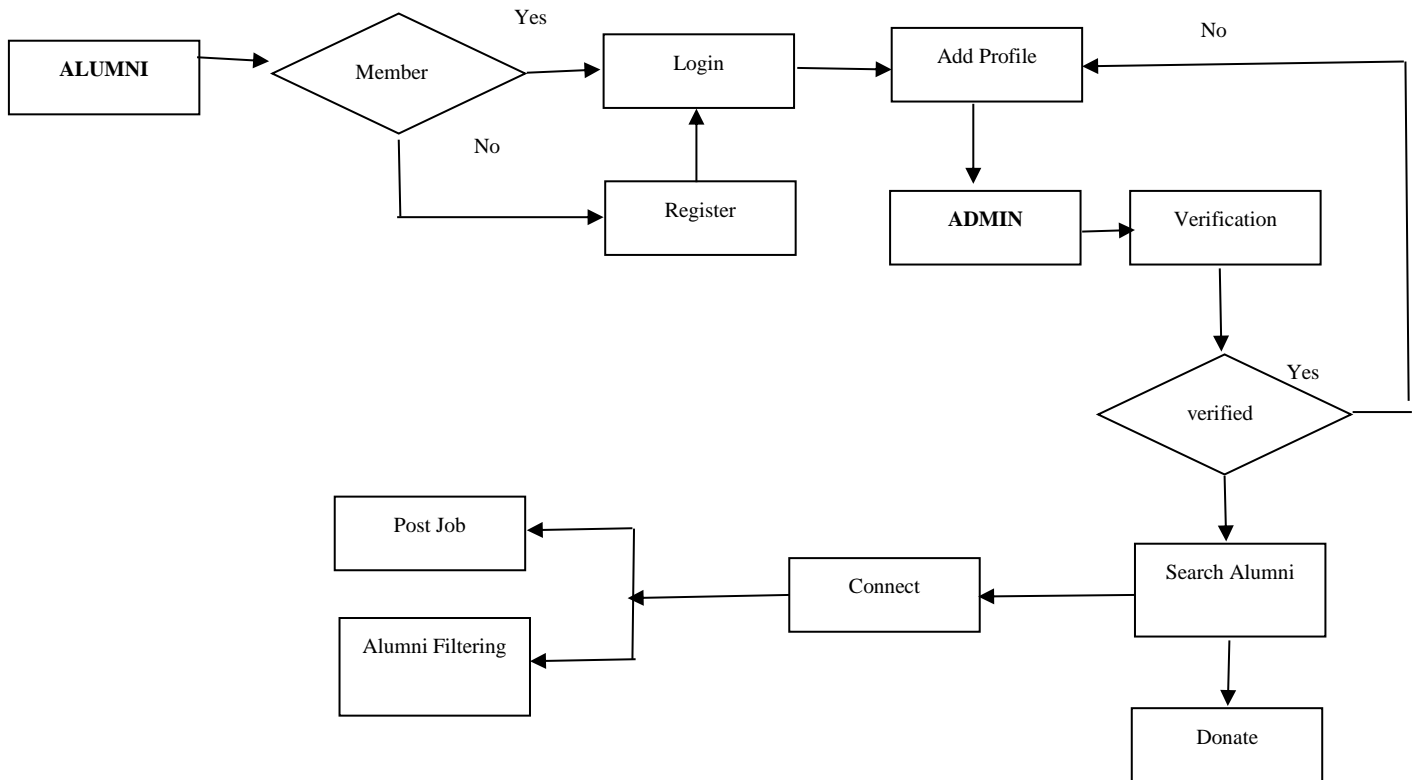
III. SCOPE

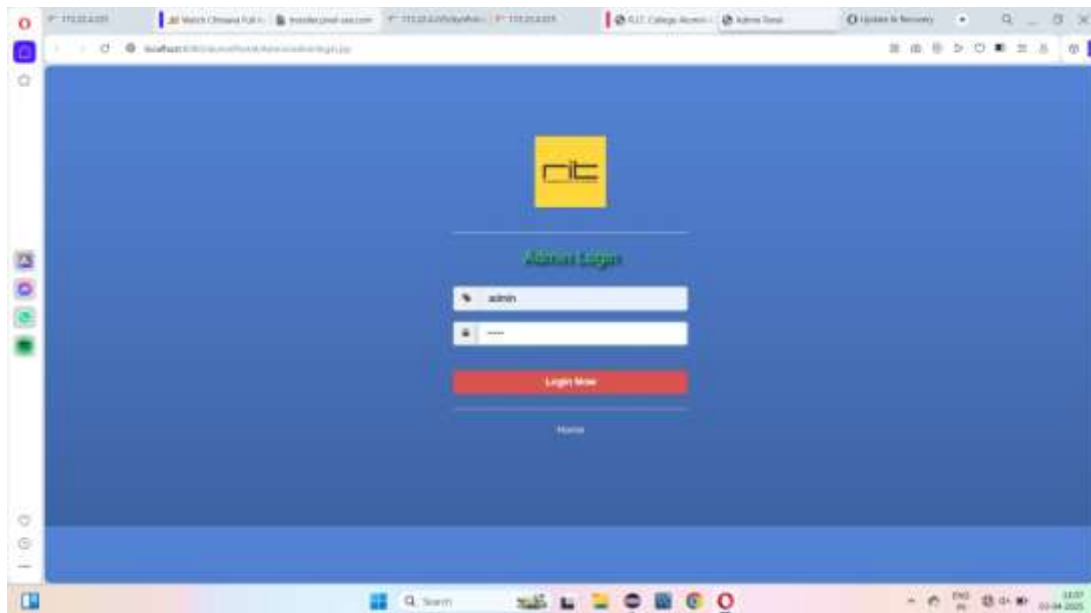

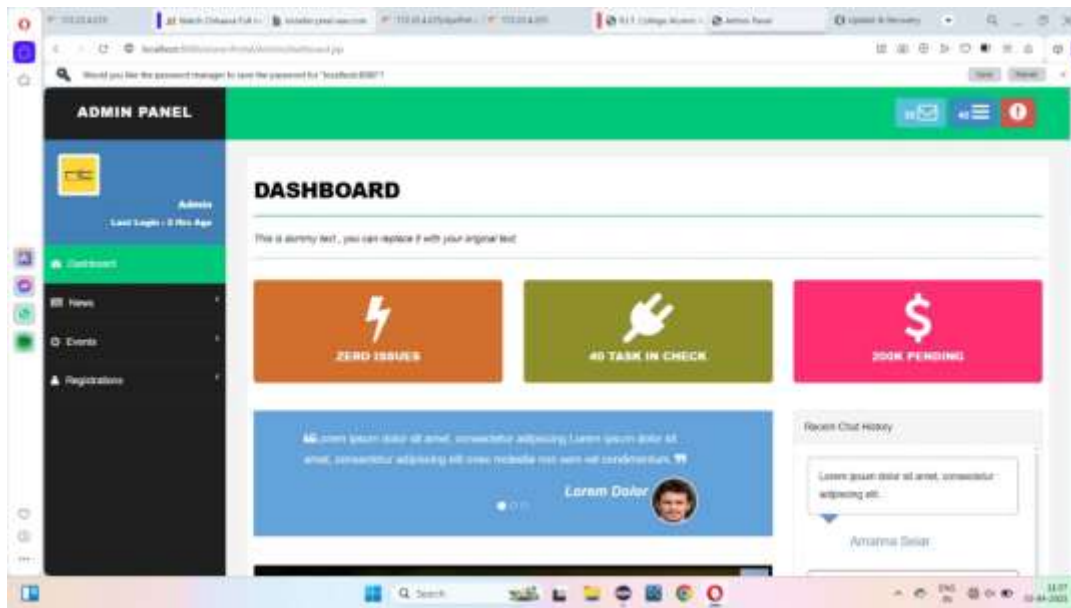


VI. PROPOSED SYSTEM
