Problem Statement

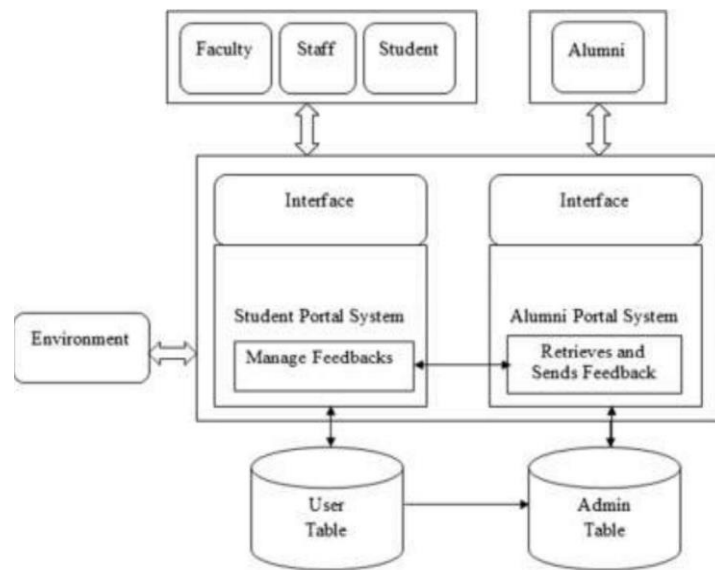
- We started this project because we saw some real gaps in how our college connects with its alumni. Here's what we noticed:

System Architecture



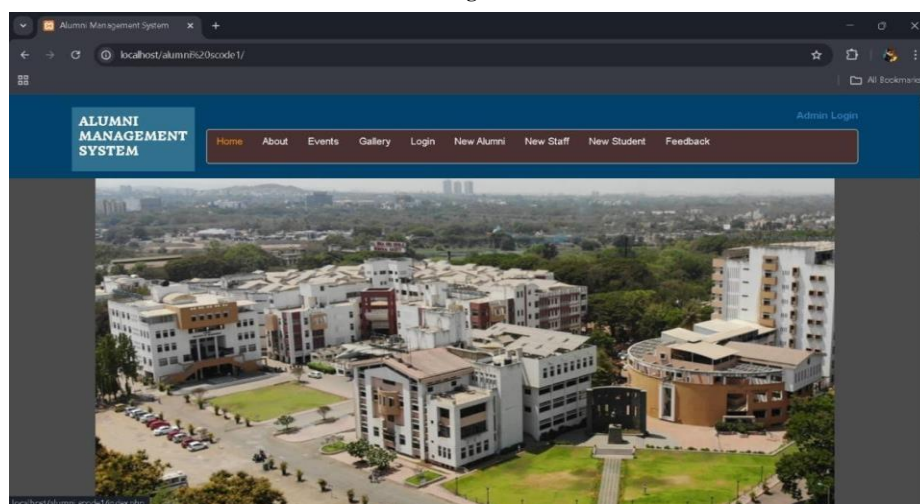
Working of the Project:

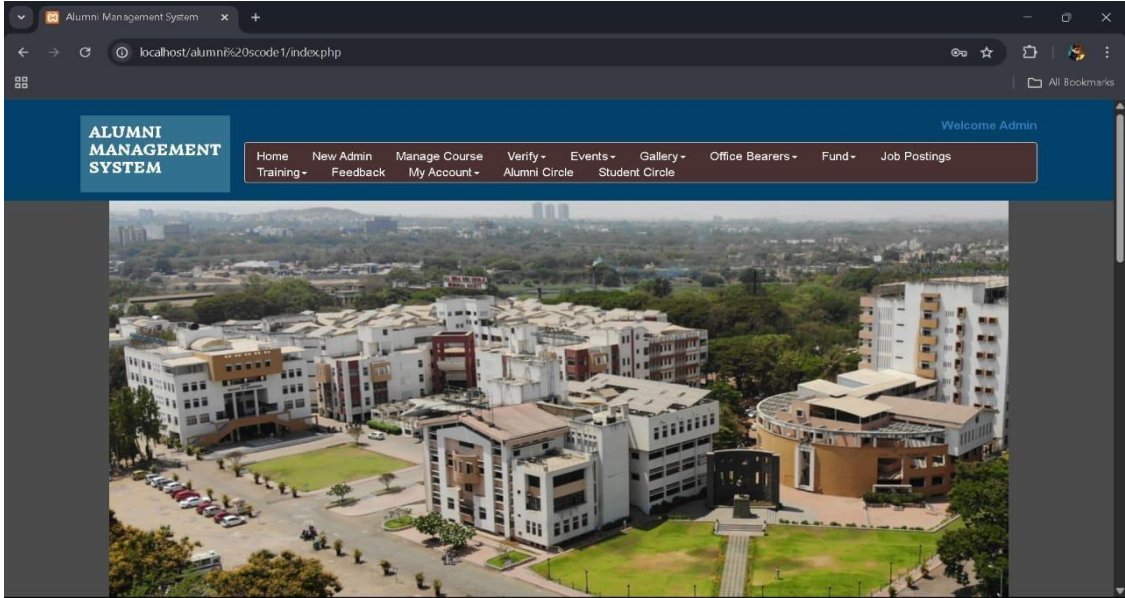

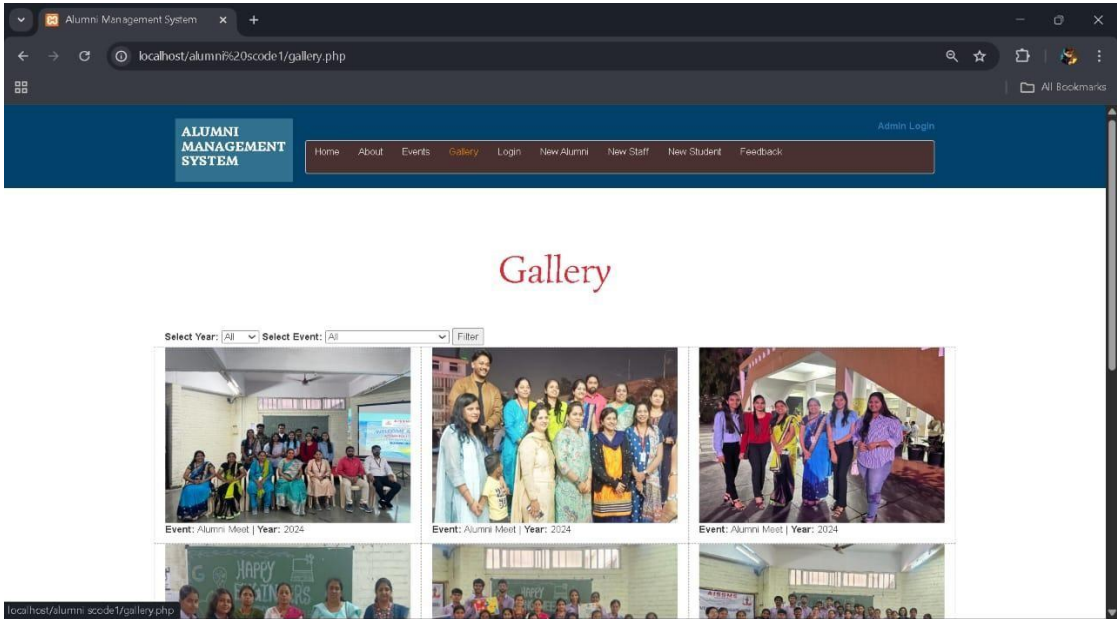
